Peter Lowy is Co-Chief Executive Officer of Westfield Corporation, a global leader in the development and operation of iconic retail destinations in major world cities. With assets valued at more than \$29 billion, the company has investment interests in a portfolio of 32 shopping centers in the United States (including the retail at the re-built World Trade Center scheduled to open in August 2016), three in the United Kingdom, and a seminal development site in Milan, Italy. The Company has undertaken a \$12 billion development program that upon its anticipated completion in 2020 is estimated to increase the value of assets under management to \$50 billion or more. Further, Westfield Airports operates major retail projects at Los Angeles International, John F. Kennedy International, Newark and Chicago O'Hare.

Mr. Lowy has over 30 years of experience in the shopping center, real estate and REIT industry having worked for Westfield since 1983. He is a member of the International Council of Shopping Centers, the Real Estate Roundtable and the National Association of Real Estate Investment Trusts. Prior to joining Westfield, he worked in investment banking both in London and New York. He holds a Bachelor of Commerce degree from the University of New South Wales, Australia.

Mr. Lowy is Founding Chairman of the Invest in America Coalition, a bi-partisan coalition of real estate, business and labor union leaders brought together to support the successful effort to reform the Foreign Investment in Real Property Tax Act (FIRPTA).

He serves as Chairman of the Homeland Security Advisory Council for Los Angeles County, on the RAND Corporation Board of Trustees, the Board of the Washington Institute for Near East Policy and is a Director of the Lowy Institute for International Policy. He is the former Chairman of the American Jewish University and is currently Chairman of the Board of the Jewish Journal of Greater Los Angeles/TRIBE Media Corp.
