



## Cincinnati-Middletown, OH-KY-IN

- In 2011, the Cincinnati metropolitan area was the 16th largest export market in the United States, with merchandise shipments totaling \$18.7 billion. This is up \$1.1 billion (6.5 percent) from the \$17.6 billion in merchandise exported in 2010.
- For the top 50 U.S. merchandise export destinations, Cincinnati ranks among the major metropolitan area exporters to Canada (\$4.2 billion), Mexico (\$2.5 billion), the United Kingdom (\$1.8 billion), Brazil (\$1.6 billion), and Singapore (\$765 million).
- Cincinnati ranks among the major metropolitan area exporters of Transportation Equipment (\$8.6 billion), Chemicals (\$2.8 billion), Machinery, Except Electrical (\$2.0 billion), Paper (\$626 million), and Fabricated Metal Products (\$509 million).
- In 2011, Cincinnati benefited from existing trade agreements, exporting \$6.7 billion to the NAFTA region and \$165 million to the CAFTA-DR region.
- 35.9 percent of Cincinnati's merchandise exports go to NAFTA countries.
