New York Exports in 2015

- Goods exports from the New York area have increased \$25.7 billion since 2009.
- On average, exports from the New York area have increased by 5.6% annually over the past 10 years.



Exports Sustain New York Area Businesses

- In 2014 (latest available), 18,464 New York area companies exported to U.S. FTA partners.
- The same year, 15,966 area companies exported to Trans-Pacific Partnership countries and 12,593 exported to the European Union.

Top New York Export Markets & Sectors


- In 2015, Hong Kong was New York's top foreign market, accounting for 11% of its total goods exports.
- Miscellaneous manufactures was New York's top export sector in 2015, accounting for 24% of the area's goods exports.



In addition to these top markets, New York is also a major exporter to:

Israel \$6.0 billion
Mexico \$5.6 billion
Belgium \$5.6 billion
Japan \$3.9 billion
India \$3.3 billion

In addition to these top sectors, other sectors where New York is a major exporter include:

- Petroleum & coal products


Current and Future FTAs Matter to New York Area Exporters

- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.

In 2015, exports to FTA markets accounted for **29%** of New York area exports



