



## Portland-Vancouver-Hillsboro, OR-WA

- In 2011, the Portland metropolitan area was the 14th largest export market in the United States, with merchandise shipments totaling \$20.9 billion. This is up \$2.3 billion (12.6 percent) from the \$18.5 billion in merchandise exported in 2010.
- For the top 50 U.S. merchandise export destinations, Portland ranks among the major metropolitan area exporters to China (\$2.9 billion), Malaysia (\$2.4 billion), Japan (\$2.1 billion), South Korea (\$934 million), and the Philippines (\$610 million).
- Portland ranks among the major metropolitan area exporters of Computer and Electronic Products (\$6.2 billion), Transportation Equipment (\$4.0 billion), Crop Production (\$3.5 billion), Machinery, Except Electrical (\$1.6 billion), and Wood Products (\$373 million).
- In 2011, Portland benefited from existing trade agreements, exporting \$5.5 billion to the NAFTA region and \$623 million to the CAFTA-DR region.
- 26.4 percent of Portland's merchandise exports go to NAFTA countries.
