- In 2010, the San Juan metropolitan area was the 14th largest export market in the United States, with merchandise shipments totaling \$20.4 billion.
- The San Juan metropolitan area accounted for 88.3 percent of Puerto Rico's merchandise exports in 2010.
- For the top 50 U.S. merchandise export destinations, San Juan ranks among the major metropolitan area exporters to the Netherlands (\$2.5 billion), the United Kingdom (\$1.3 billion), France (\$1.1 billion), Italy (\$634 million) and the Dominican Republic (\$413 million).
- San Juan ranks among the major metropolitan area exporters of Chemicals (\$17.7 billion), Miscellaneous Manufactured Commodities (\$735 million), and Beverages and Tobacco Products (\$76 million).
- In 2010, San Juan benefited from existing trade agreements, exporting \$1.3 billion to the NAFTA region and \$459 million to the CAFTA-DR region.
- 6 percent of San Juan's merchandise exports go to NAFTA countries.
