San Antonio Exports in 2015

- Goods exports from the San Antonio area have increased \$11.5 billion since 2009.
- On average, exports from the San Antonio area have increased by 21.1% annually over the past 10 years.




Exports Sustain San Antonio Area Businesses

- In 2014 (latest available), 1,308 San Antonio area companies exported to U.S. FTA partners.
- The same year, 1,218 area companies exported to Trans-Pacific Partnership countries and 346 exported to the European Union.



Note: Exporter counts reflect the number of companies, not establishments, and are therefore not additive across industries and geographies





Top San Antonio Export Markets & Sectors

- In 2015, Canada was San Antonio's top foreign market, accounting for 32% of its total goods exports.
- Transportation equipment was San Antonio's top export sector in 2015, accounting for 10% of the area's goods exports.


Top San Antonio Area Export Markets


Current and Future FTAs Matter to San Antonio Area Exporters

- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.

In 2015, exports to FTA markets accounted for **75%** of San Antonio area exports


