
Connecticut Depends on World Markets

- Exports from Connecticut helped contribute to the \$2.26 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2015.



Connecticut's Top 5 Export Categories (Millions of U.S. Dollars)




Exports Support Jobs

- Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 11.5 million in 2015, up 1.9 million from 2009.

98% of these jobs were supported by manufactured goods exports


Exports Sustain Thousands of Connecticut Businesses

- A total of 5,717 companies exported from Connecticut locations in 2014.





Number of Employees by Country of UBO





Free Trade Agreements

- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Connecticut's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$4.2 billion in 2015.

In 2015, exports to FTA markets accounted for **28%** of Connecticut exports



Since 2005, exports from Connecticut to FTA markets have grown by **35%**

Connecticut's Metropolitan Exports

- Hartford-West Hartford-East Hartford is the 29th largest metro area reporting goods exports nationwide.

Bridgeport-Stamford-Norwalk	\$9.2 billion	41.3%
