
Iowa Depends on World Markets

- Exports from Iowa helped contribute to the \$2.26 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2015.



(Millions of U.S. Dollars)




Iowa's Top 5 Export Categories

Exports Support Jobs

- Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 11.5 million in 2015, up 1.9 million from 2009.

Exports Sustain Thousands of Iowa Businesses



- A total of 3,374 companies exported from Iowa locations in 2014.

...and **20%** of known Iowa goods export value







Number of Employees by Country of UBO





Free Trade Agreements


- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Iowa's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$7.3 billion in 2015.

In 2015, exports to FTA markets accounted for **55%** of Iowa exports



Since 2005, exports from Iowa to FTA markets have grown by **73%**

Iowa's Metropolitan Exports

- Davenport-Moline-Rock Island is the 48th largest metro area reporting goods exports nationwide.
