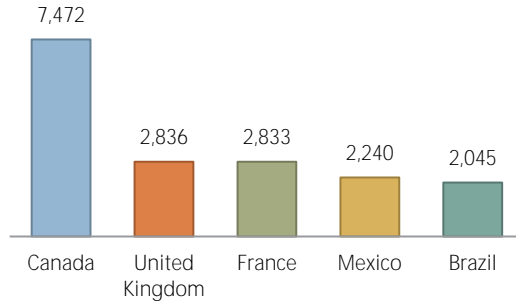
Kentucky Depends on World Markets

- Exports from Kentucky helped contribute to the \$2.21 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2016.

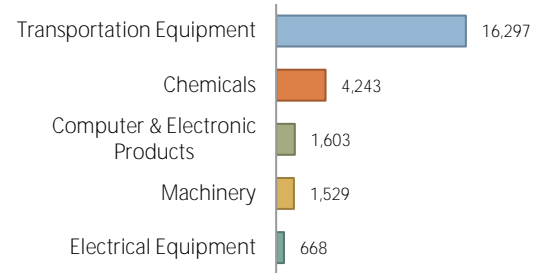

Exports Support Jobs

- Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 11.5 million in 2015, up 1.9 million from 2009.

Exports Sustain Thousands of Kentucky Businesses

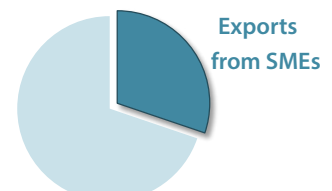
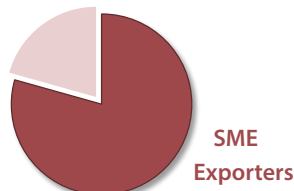
- A total of 4,606 companies exported from Kentucky locations in 2014.

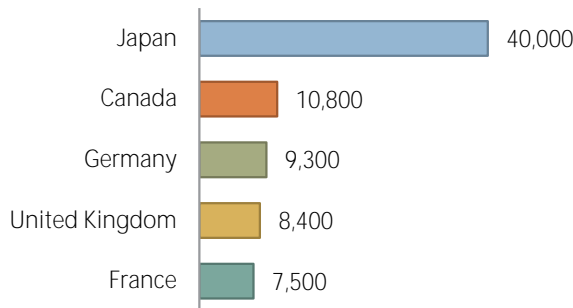

Number of Employees by Country of UBO



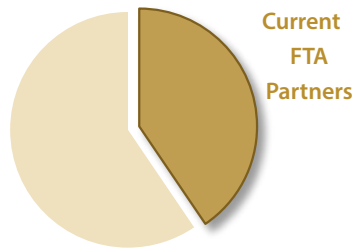

Free Trade Agreements

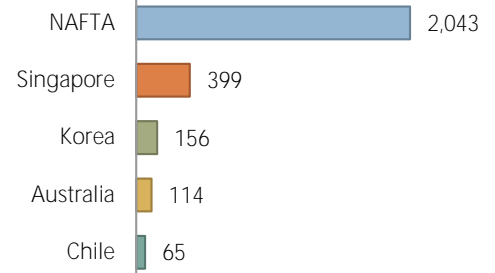
- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Kentucky's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$11.8 billion in 2016.

In 2016, exports to FTA markets accounted for **41%** of Kentucky exports



Since 2006, exports from Kentucky to FTA markets have grown by **32%**

Kentucky's Metropolitan Exports

- Cincinnati is the 13th largest metro area reporting exports nationwide.
