
Missouri Depends on World Markets

- Exports from Missouri helped contribute to the \$2.33 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2017.



Missouri's Top 5 Export Markets (Millions of U.S. Dollars)




Missouri's Top 5 Export Categories (Millions of U.S. Dollars)



Exports Support Jobs

- Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 10.7 million in 2016, up 1.2 million from 2006.

77% of these jobs were supported by manufactured goods exports


Exports Sustain Thousands of Missouri Businesses

- A total of 6,008 companies exported from Missouri locations in 2015.





Number of Employees by Country of UBO





Free Trade Agreements


- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Missouri's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$8.9 billion in 2017.

In 2017, exports to FTA markets accounted for **62%** of Missouri exports

- St. Louis is the 38th largest metro area reporting exports nationwide.
