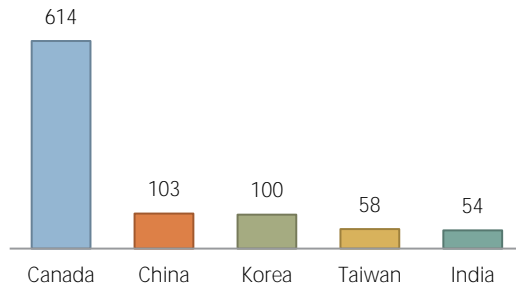

- Exports from Montana helped contribute to the \$2.21 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2016.

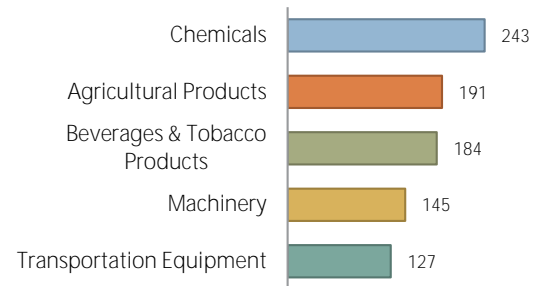

Exports Support Jobs

- Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 11.5 million in 2015, up 1.9 million from 2009.

Exports Sustain Thousands of Montana Businesses

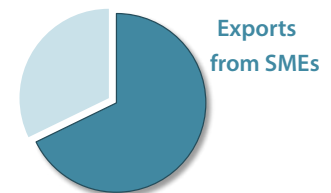
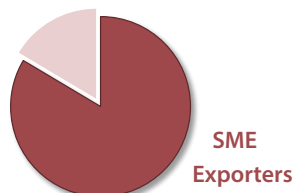
- A total of 1,556 companies exported from Montana locations in 2014.

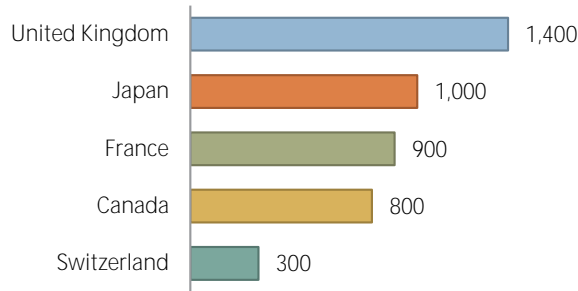

Number of Employees by Country of UBO



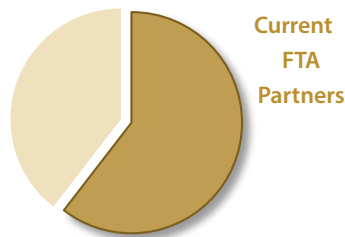

Free Trade Agreements

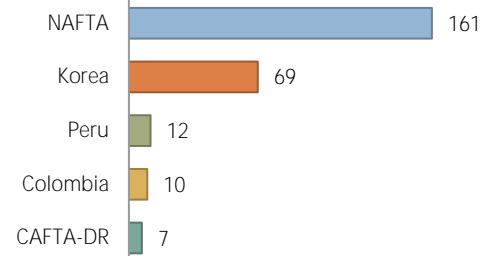
- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Montana's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$811.7 million in 2016.

In 2016, exports to FTA markets accounted for **60%** of Montana exports



Since 2006, exports from Montana to FTA markets have grown by **42%**

Montana's Metropolitan Exports

- Great Falls is the 356th largest metro area reporting exports nationwide.

Missoula	\$69 million	5.8%
Billings	\$67 million	5.6%
