
## Pennsylvania Depends on World Markets

- Exports from Pennsylvania helped contribute to the \$2.26 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2015.



Pennsylvania's Top 5 Export Categories (Millions of U.S. Dollars)




## Exports Support Jobs

- Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 11.5 million in 2015, up 1.9 million from 2009.

**91%** of these jobs were supported by manufactured goods exports


## Exports Sustain Thousands of Pennsylvania Businesses

- A total of 15,758 companies exported from Pennsylvania locations in 2014.





Number of Employees by Country of UBO





## Free Trade Agreements


- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Pennsylvania's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$19.2 billion in 2015.

In 2015, exports to FTA markets accounted for **49%** of Pennsylvania exports



Since 2005, exports from Pennsylvania to FTA markets have grown by **68%**

## Pennsylvania's Metropolitan Exports

- Philadelphia-Camden-Wilmington is the 12th largest metro area reporting goods exports nationwide.
