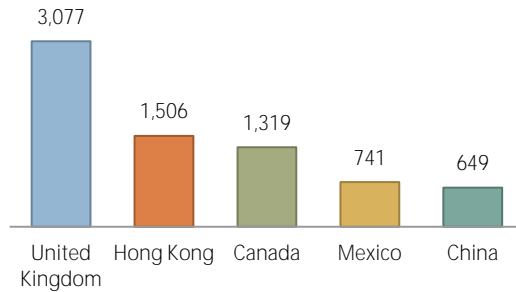
Utah Depends on World Markets

- Exports from Utah helped contribute to the \$2.21 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2016.

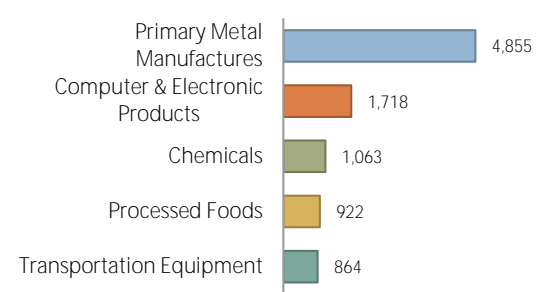

Utah's Top 5 Export Categories (Millions of U.S. Dollars)

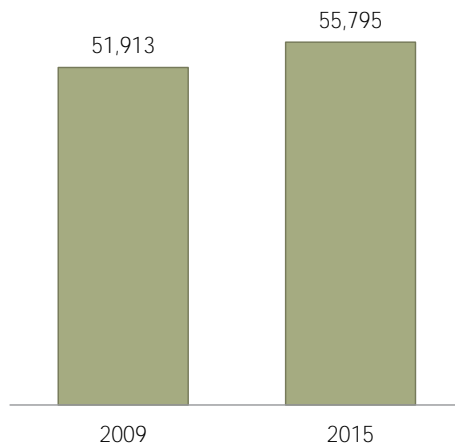


Exports Support Jobs

- Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 11.5 million in 2015, up 1.9 million from 2009.

Exports Sustain Thousands of Utah Businesses

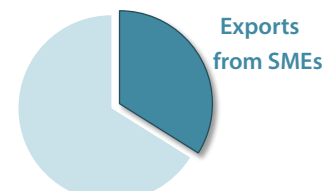
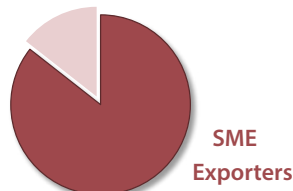
- A total of 3,544 companies exported from Utah locations in 2014.

...and **34%** of known Utah goods export value





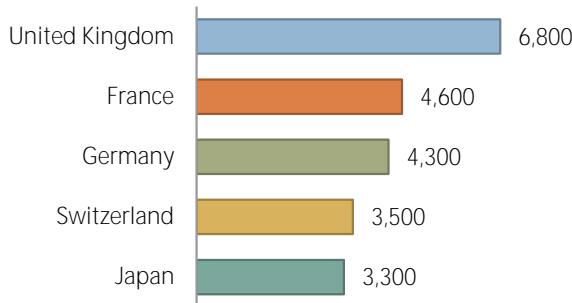

Number of Employees by Country of UBO



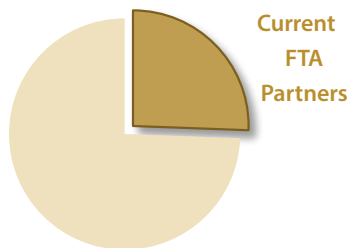

Free Trade Agreements

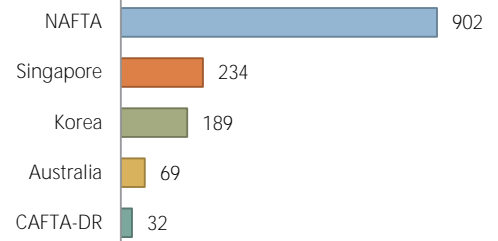
- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Utah's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$3.1 billion in 2016.

In 2016, exports to FTA markets accounted for **26%** of Utah exports



Since 2006, exports from Utah to FTA markets have grown by **92%**

- Salt Lake City is the 27th largest metro area reporting exports nationwide.
