
Wisconsin Depends on World Markets

- Exports from Wisconsin helped contribute to the \$2.26 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2015.



Wisconsin's Top 5 Export Categories (Millions of U.S. Dollars)




Exports Support Jobs

- Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 11.5 million in 2015, up 1.9 million from 2009.

Exports Sustain Thousands of Wisconsin Businesses


- A total of 8,857 companies exported from Wisconsin locations in 2014.



Number of Employees by Country of UBO





Free Trade Agreements


- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Wisconsin's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$12.6 billion in 2015.

In 2015, exports to FTA markets accounted for **56%** of Wisconsin exports



Since 2005, exports from Wisconsin to FTA markets have grown by **57%**

Wisconsin's Metropolitan Exports

- Milwaukee-Waukesha-West Allis is the 41st largest metro area reporting goods exports nationwide.
