

## China Standards Notes

- The Certification and Accreditation Administration (CNCA) will require China Compulsory Certification (CCC) and labeling for 3G end terminal devices beginning January 1, 2010. Three standards for testing 3G products were added to the existing “Electric and Electronic Products Compulsory Certification Implementation Rule” (CNCA-08C-031:2007)

- “Regulations for the Management of Recycling and Disposal of Waste from Electrical and Electronic Products” (WEEE) was approved by the State Council to take effect January 1, 2011. Mirroring an earlier EU directive, the ‘Regulations’ make manufacturers responsible for WEEE management.
