

## China Standards Notes

- The General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine (AQSIQ) and the General Administration of Customs (GAC) jointly announced the newly adjusted 2010 import/export commodities inspection catalogue, which was enforced on January 1, 2010. - To ensure the quality of imported dairy products and to systemize management of imported products, exporters of dairy product need to submit hygiene certificate when clearing through the Chinese customs. By March 1, 2010, products without hygiene certificate would not be able to clear through the Chinese customs. This requirement was initially introduced in July, 2006. - China will standardize recycling and disposal of electrical and electronic product waste. *The Regulations for Recycling and Disposal of Electrical and Electronic Product Waste* will take effect on Jan. 1, 2011. To raise the profile of the new regulations, ten departments under the State Council, including the Ministry of Environmental Protection, the National Development and Reform Commission and the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology (MIIT), held a competition on the recycling and disposal of electrical and electronic product waste. <http://www.sinofile.net/clients/amcweb.nsf/amcA/81764BB35A6F4CD64825769A00210EEB?opendocument>
