- In 2014, 96% of Minneapolis goods exporters shipped manufactured products overseas.

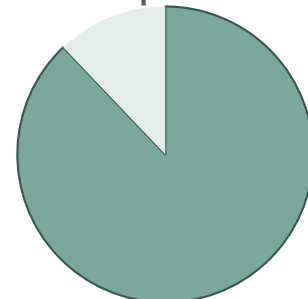

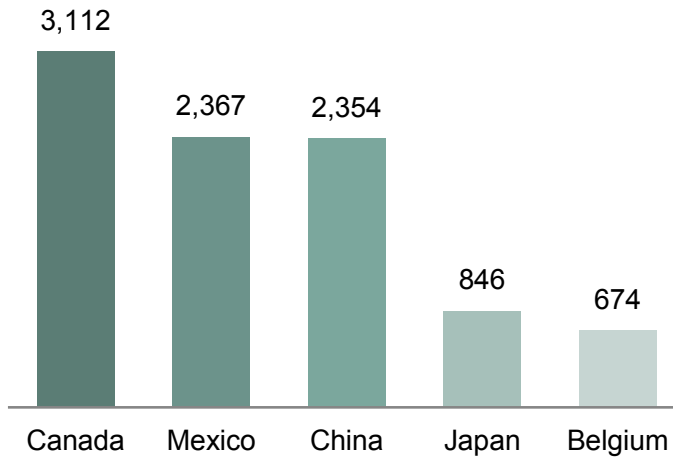

In addition to these top markets, Minneapolis is also a major exporter to:

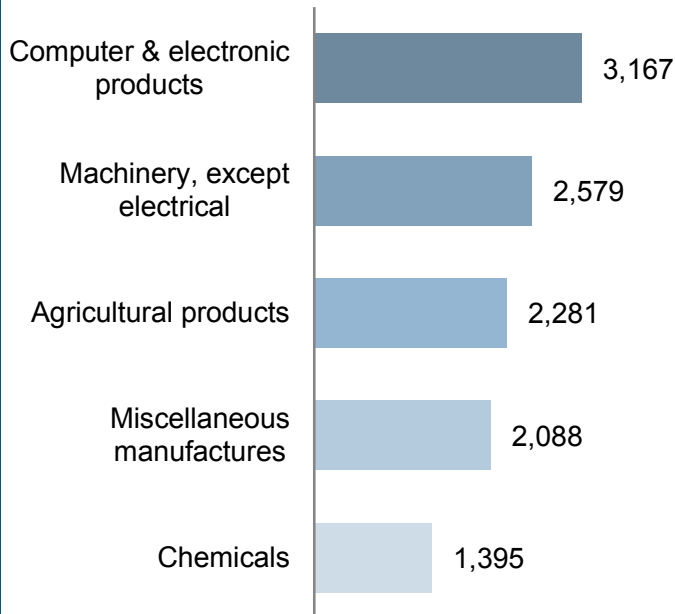
- Philippines \$443 million
