Salt Lake City Exports in 2016

- Goods exports from the Salt Lake City area have increased \$3.6 billion since 2006.
- On average, exports from the Salt Lake City area have increased by 5.5% annually over the past 10 years.


Exports Sustain Salt Lake City Area Businesses

Note: Exporter counts reflect the number of companies, not establishments, and are therefore not additive across industries and geographies




Top Salt Lake City Export Markets

Salt Lake City, UT Merchandise Exports in 2016






Top Salt Lake City Export Sectors
