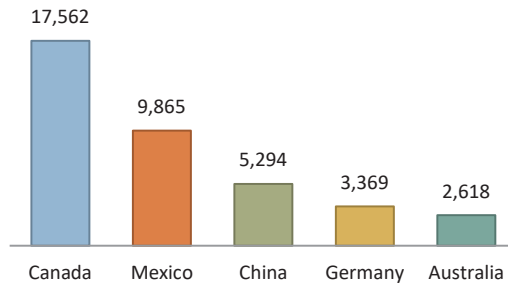
Illinois Depends on World Markets

- Exports from Illinois helped contribute to the \$2.33 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2017.

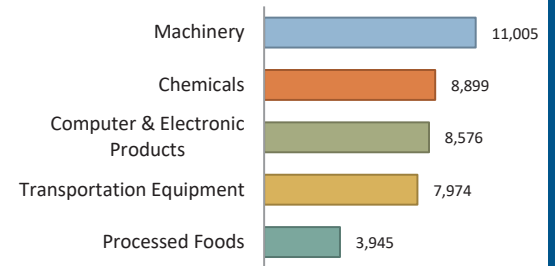

Illinois's Top 5 Export Categories (Millions of U.S. Dollars)

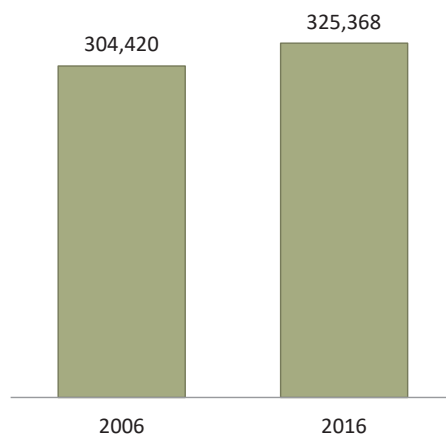


Exports Support Jobs

- Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 10.7 million in 2016, up 1.2 million from 2006.

Exports Sustain Thousands of Illinois Businesses

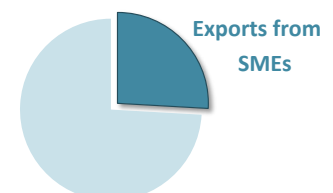
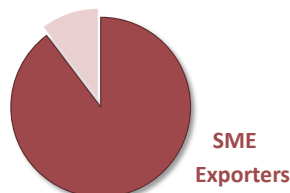
- A total of 22,510 companies exported from Illinois locations in 2015.

...and **26%** of known Illinois goods export value



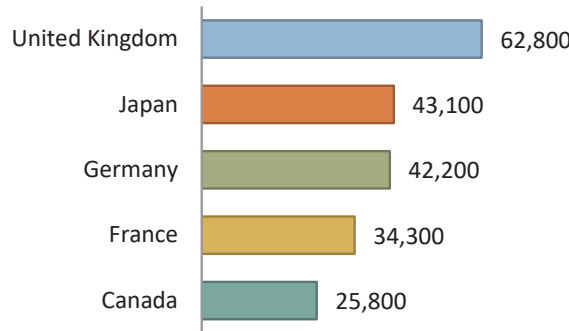

Number of Employees by Country of UBO



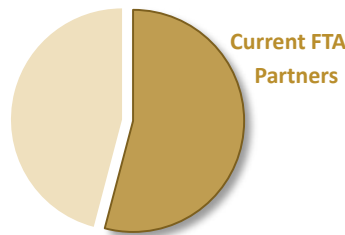

Free Trade Agreements

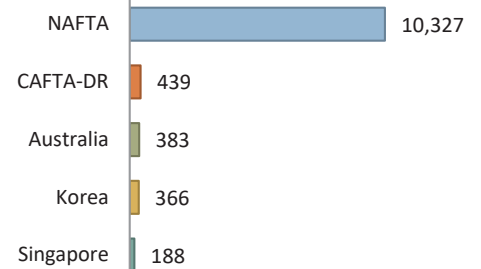
- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Illinois's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$35.1 billion in 2017.

In 2017, exports to FTA markets accounted for **54%** of Illinois exports



Since 2007, exports from Illinois to FTA markets have grown by **52%**

- Chicago-Naperville-Elgin is the 5th largest metro area reporting exports nationwide.
