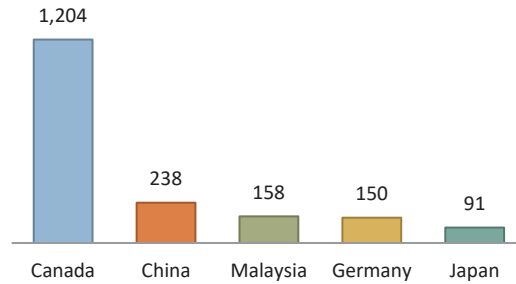
Maine Exports, Jobs, & Foreign Investment

Maine Depends on World Markets

- Exports from Maine helped contribute to the \$2.33 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2017.

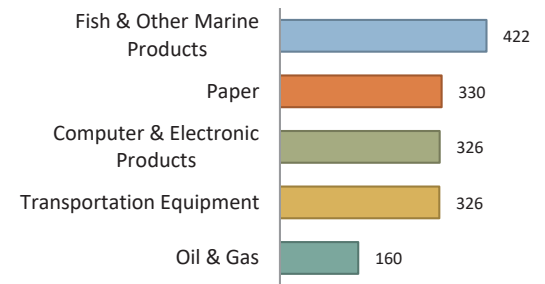

Maine goods exports in 2017

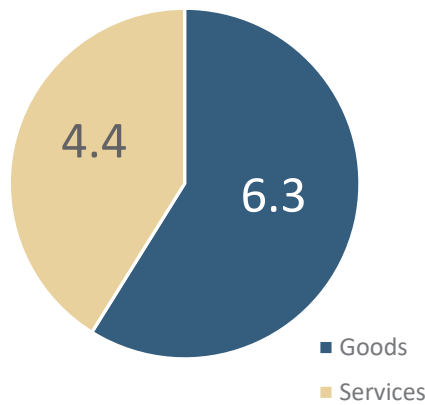
Maine's Top 5 Export Categories

Exports Support Jobs

- Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 10.7 million in 2016, up 1.2 million from 2006.

53% of these jobs were supported by manufactured goods exports

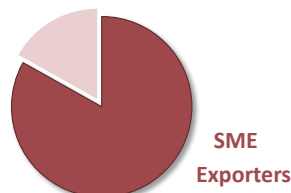
Exports Sustain Thousands of Maine Businesses

- A total of 2,087 companies exported from Maine locations in 2015.

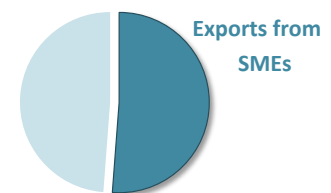

...and **51%** of known Maine goods export value





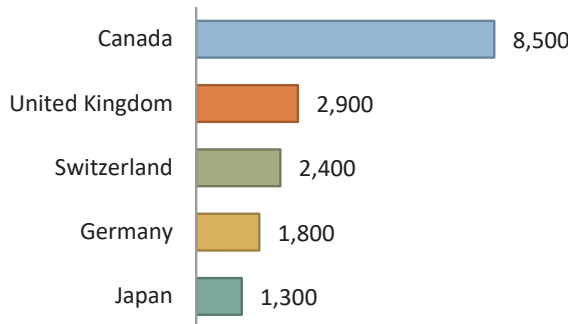

Number of Employees by Country of UBO



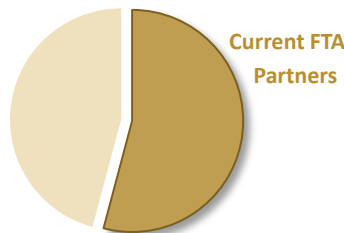

Free Trade Agreements

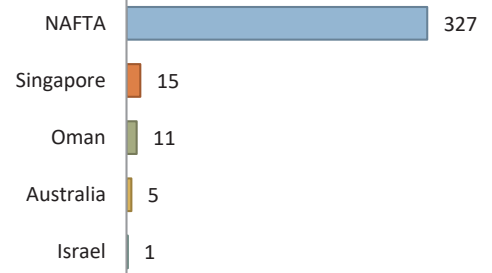
- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Maine's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$1.4 billion in 2017.

In 2017, exports to FTA markets accounted for **54%** of Maine exports



Since 2007, exports from Maine to FTA markets have grown by **25%**

- Portland-South Portland is the 132nd largest metro area reporting exports nationwide.

Lewiston-Auburn	\$102 million	4.10%
