New Hampshire Depends on World Markets

- Exports from New Hampshire helped contribute to the \$2.33 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2017.

Exports Support Jobs

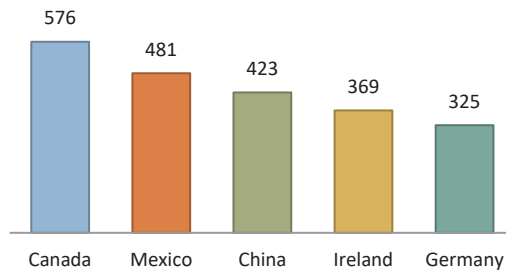
- Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 10.7 million in 2016, up 1.2 million from 2006.

Exports Sustain Thousands of New Hampshire Businesses

- A total of 2,610 companies exported from New Hampshire locations in 2015.

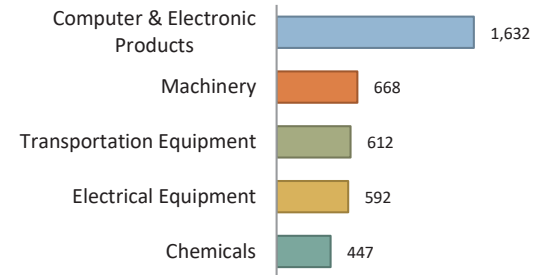

New Hampshire's Top 5 Export Markets (Millions of U.S. Dollars)



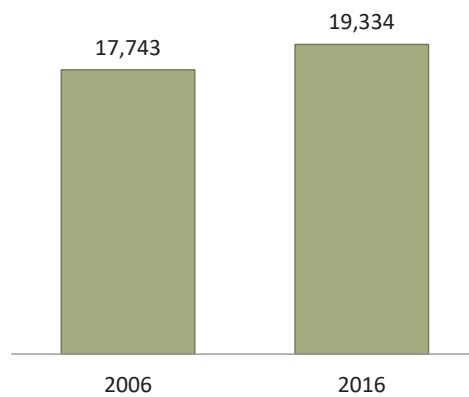
New Hampshire goods exports in 2017

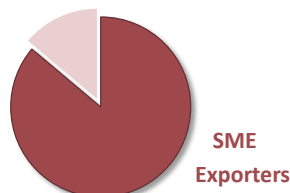

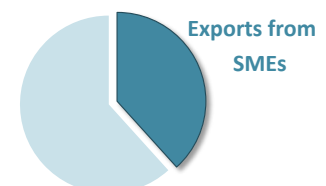

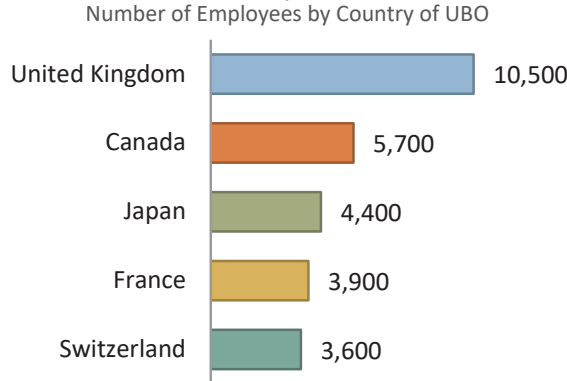

New Hampshire Employment in Foreign-Owned Companies



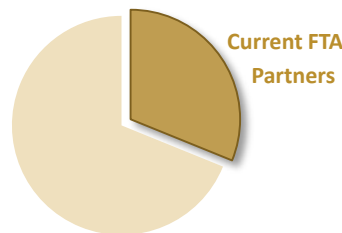

Free Trade Agreements

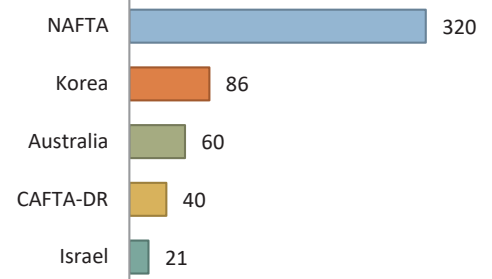
- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- New Hampshire's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$1.6 billion in 2017.

In 2017, exports to FTA markets accounted for **31%** of New Hampshire exports



Since 2007, exports from New Hampshire to FTA markets have grown by **56%**

- Manchester-Nashua is the 118th largest metro area reporting exports nationwide.
