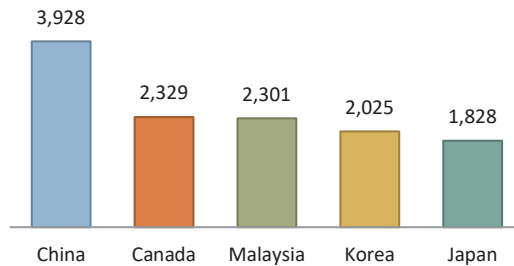
Oregon Depends on World Markets

- Exports from Oregon helped contribute to the \$2.33 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2017.

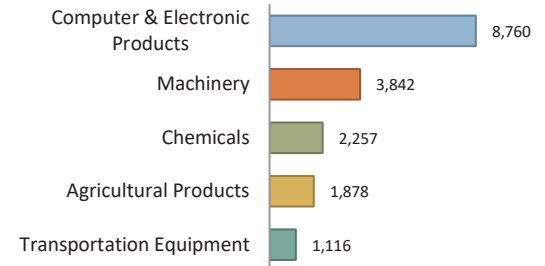

Oregon's Top 5 Export Markets (Millions of U.S. Dollars)



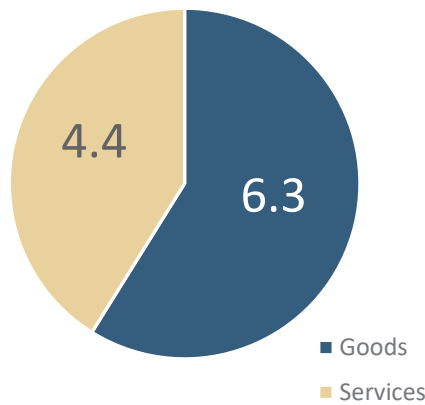
Oregon's Top 5 Export Categories (Millions of U.S. Dollars)



Exports Support Jobs

- Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 10.7 million in 2016, up 1.2 million from 2006.

95% of these jobs were supported by manufactured goods exports

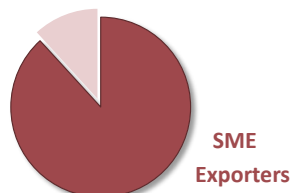
Exports Sustain Thousands of Oregon Businesses

- A total of 5,953 companies exported from Oregon locations in 2015.

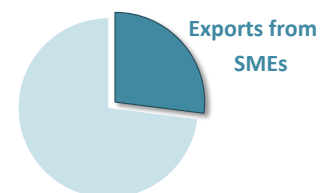

...and **27%** of known Oregon goods export value





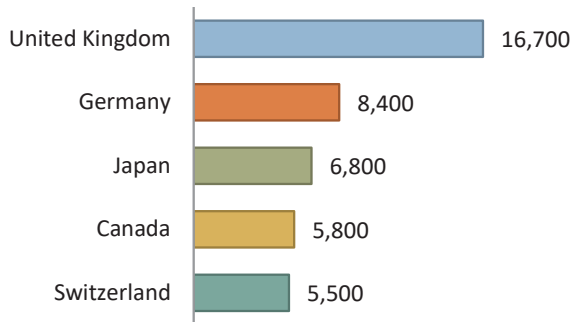

Number of Employees by Country of UBO



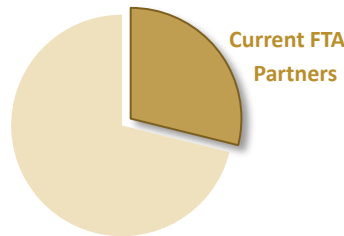

Free Trade Agreements

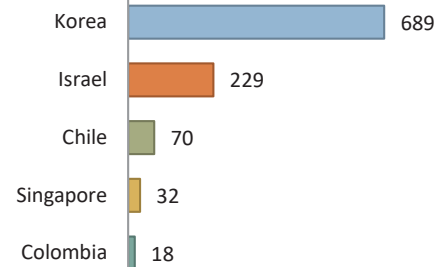
- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Oregon's exports to U.S. FTA partners totaled \$6.3 billion in 2017.

In 2017, exports to FTA markets accounted for **29%** of Oregon exports

Oregon's Metropolitan Exports

- Portland-Vancouver-Hillsboro is the 17th largest metro area reporting exports nationwide.
