Commerce Initiates Antidumping Duty and Countervailing Duty Investigations of Aluminum Extrusions from Fifteen Trading Partners

On October 25, 2023, the U.S. Department of Commerce (Commerce) announced the initiation of antidumping duty (AD) and countervailing duty (CVD) investigations of aluminum extrusions from the People's Republic of China (China), Indonesia, Mexico, and the Republic of Turkey (Turkey), as well as AD investigations from Colombia, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, India, Italy, the Republic of Korea (Korea), Malaysia, Taiwan, Thailand, United Arab Emirates (UAE), and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (Vietnam).
