The Big Iron IVP includes a dedicated international visitors day at the **Big Iron Farm Show**, which is the largest farm show in the Upper Midwest and features the latest technologies in large-scale agriculture production. The show is ideal for international buyers and U.S. manufacturers or distributors of large agricultural equipment, and it is expected to include more than 900 exhibitors and attract more than 60,000 attendees.
