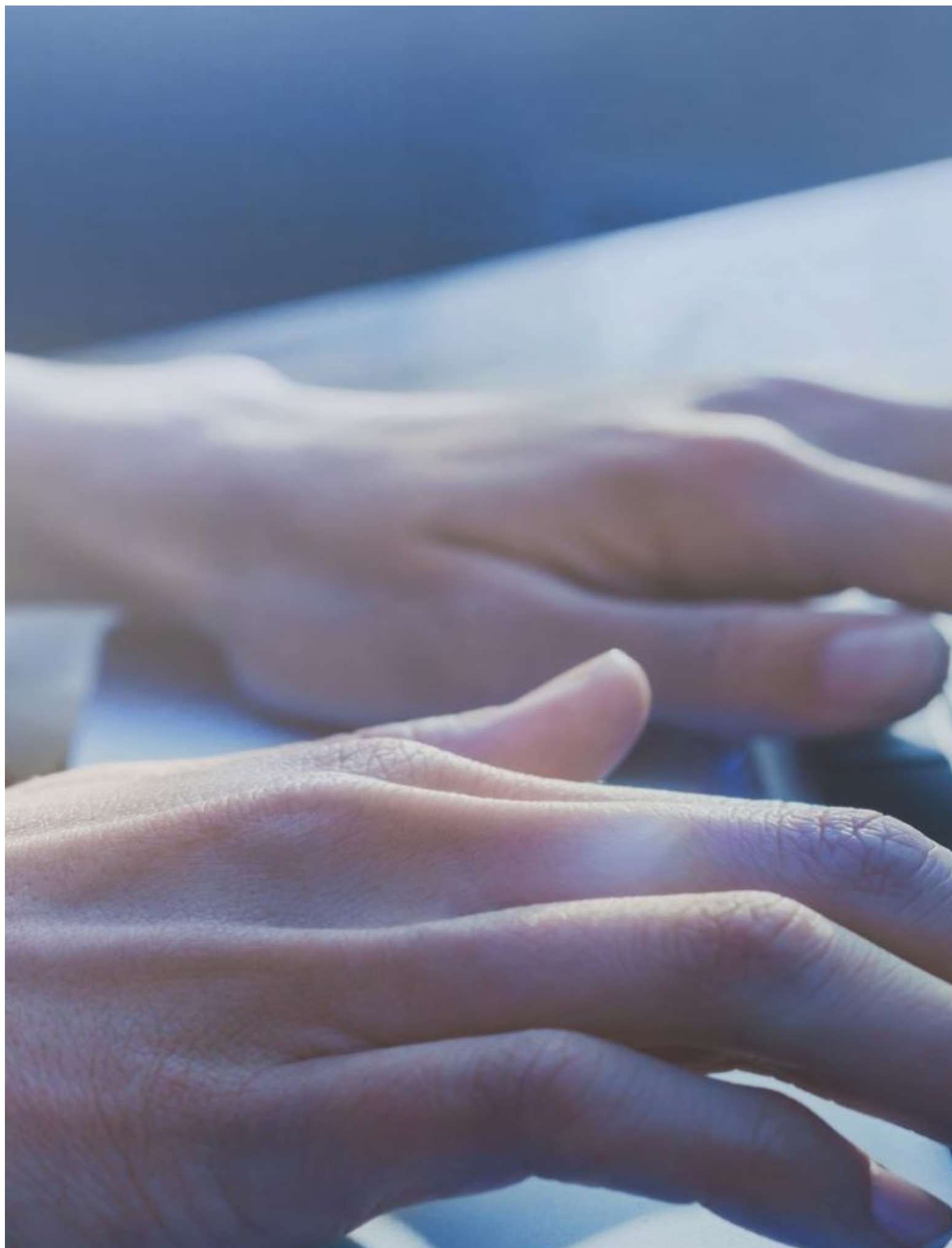

Final Affirmative Determinations in the Antidumping and Countervailing Duty Investigations of Non-Refillable Steel Cylinders from India

On April 16, 2024, the Department of Commerce (Commerce) announced its final determinations in the antidumping duty (AD) and countervailing duty (CVD) investigations of non-refillable steel cylinders from India.

Final Dumping Rates

Exporter/producer	Dumping Rate	Cash Deposit Rate (Adjusted for Subsidy Offset)
Bhiwadi Cylinders Private Limited/Sapphire (India) Private Limited*	6.27%	4.13%
Inox India Limited	0.00%	0.00%
All Others	6.27%	4.13%

* Commerce has determined to collapse Bhiwadi Cylinders Private Limited and Sapphire (India) Private Limited and treat them as a single entity.

Final Subsidy Rates

Exporter/Producer	Subsidy Rate
Bhiwadi Cylinders Private Limited*	2.48%
Inox India Limited	2.26%
All Others	2.38%

* Commerce has determined that Sapphire (India) Private Limited is cross-owned with Bhiwadi Cylinders Private Limited.
