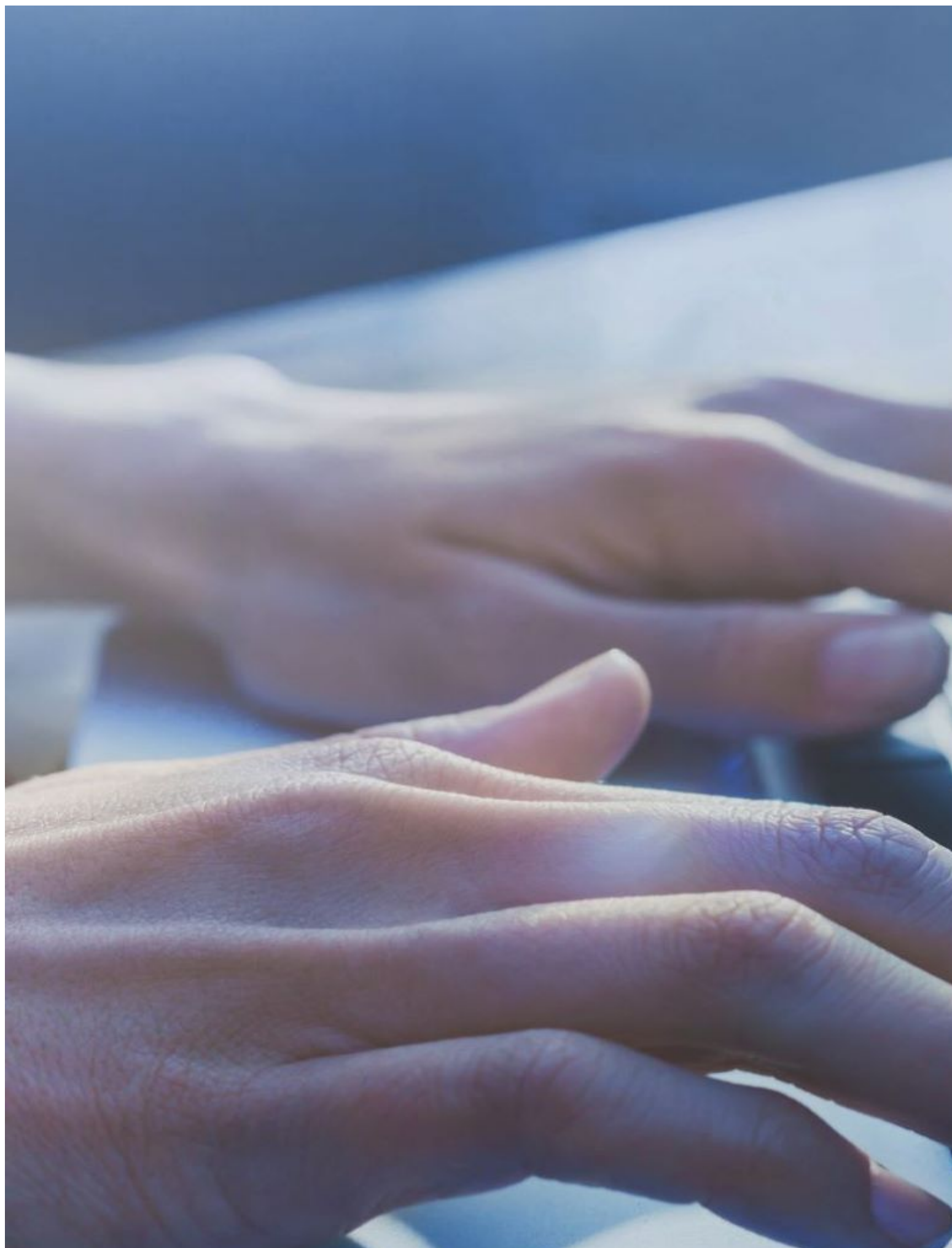

# Final Determinations in the AD and CVD Investigation of Ferrosilicon from Russia

## Final Affirmative Determinations in the Antidumping and Countervailing Duty Investigations of Ferrosilicon from the Russian Federation

On September 12, 2024, the U.S. Department of Commerce (Commerce) announced its final affirmative determinations in the antidumping duty (AD) and countervailing duty (CVD) investigations of ferrosilicon from the Russian Federation (Russia).

### Final Dumping Rate:
