# Final Determinations in the Antidumping Duty (AD) and Countervailing Duty (CVD) Investigations of Aluminum Lithographic Printing Plates from the People's Republic of China (China) and Japan

On September 23, 2024, Commerce announced final determinations in the AD investigations of aluminum lithographic printing plates from China and Japan, and the final determination in the CVD investigation of aluminum lithographic printing plates from China.
