Commerce Preliminary Countervailing Duty Investigation of Ceramic Tile from India

Preliminary Determination in the Countervailing Duty Investigation of Ceramic Tile from India

On September 24, 2024, the U.S. Department of Commerce (Commerce) announced its preliminary determination in the countervailing duty (CVD) investigation of ceramic tile from India. Commerce is conducting a concurrent antidumping duty (AD) investigation of ceramic tile from India. The final determination of the CVD investigation is aligned with the final determination of the companion AD investigation, currently scheduled for February 5, 2025, unless extended.
