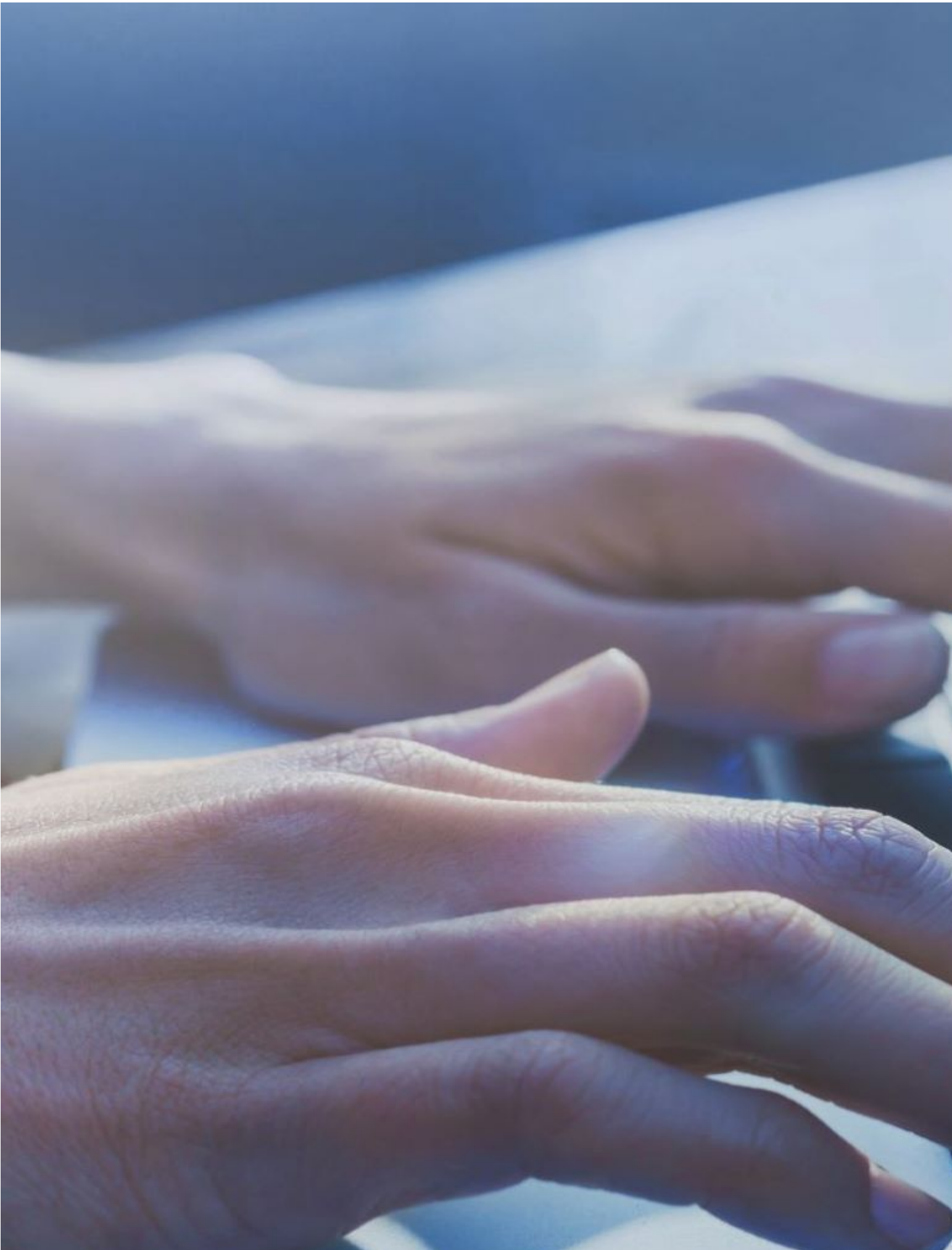

Preliminary Affirmative Determination in the Antidumping Duty Investigation of Large Top Mount Combination Refrigerator-Freezers from the Kingdom of Thailand

On January 23, 2025, the U.S. Department of Commerce (Commerce) announced its preliminary affirmative determination in the antidumping duty (AD) investigation of large top mount combination refrigerator-freezers from the Kingdom of Thailand (Thailand).
