

Preliminary Affirmative Determinations in the Countervailing Duty Investigations of Corrosion-Resistant Steel Products from Multiple Trading Partners

On February 4, 2025, the U.S. Department of Commerce (Commerce) announced the affirmative preliminary determinations in the countervailing duty (CVD) investigations of corrosion-resistant steel products (CORE) from Brazil, Canada, Mexico, and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (Vietnam). Commerce is concurrently conducting AD investigations on CORE from Australia, Brazil, Canada, Mexico, the Netherlands, South Africa, Taiwan, the Republic of Türkiye (Türkiye), the United Arab Emirates (UAE), and Vietnam.
