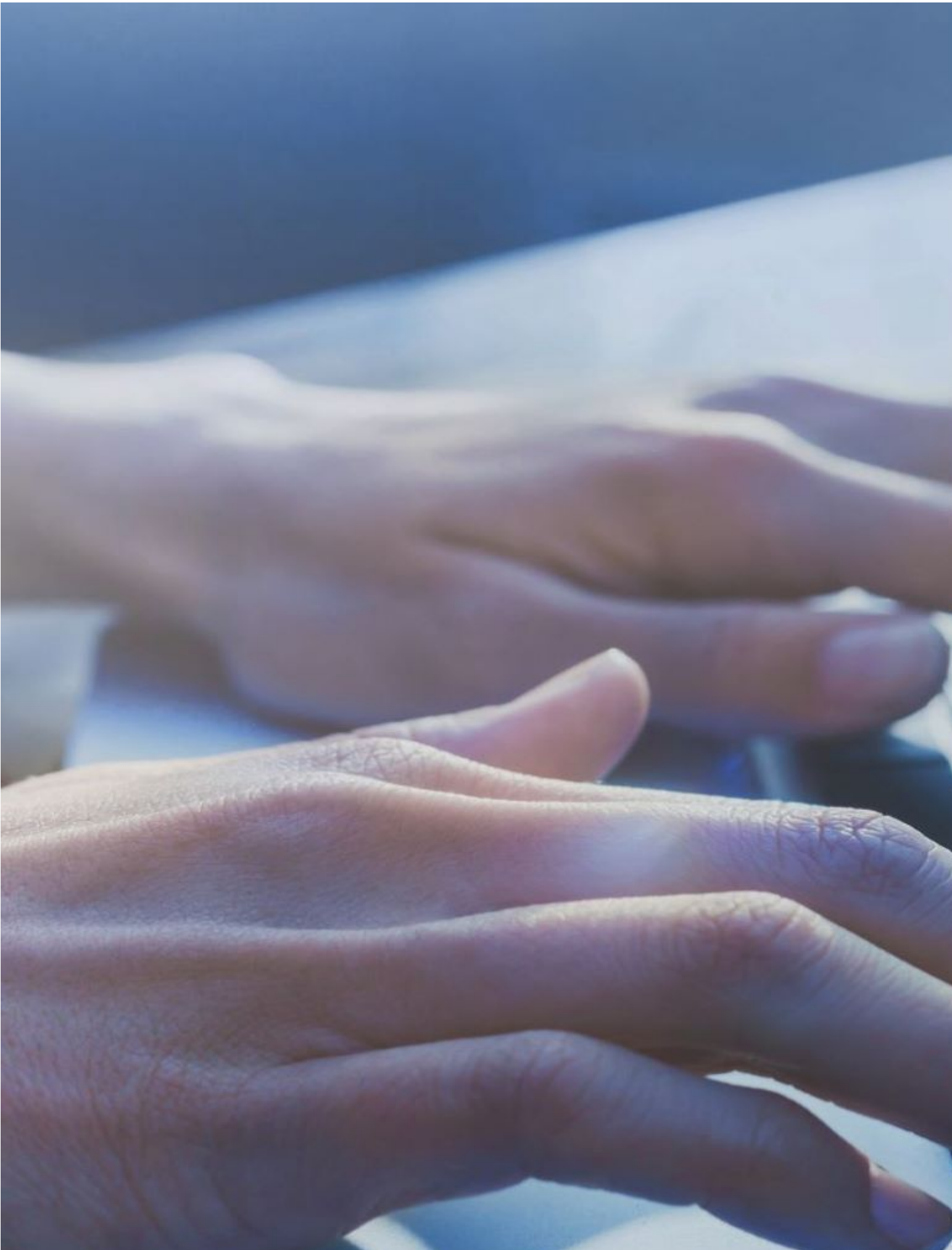

# Final Determinations in the AD CVD Investigations of Melamine from India

## Final Affirmative Determinations in the Antidumping Duty and Countervailing Duty Investigations of Melamine from India

On February 7, 2025, the U.S. Department of Commerce (Commerce) announced its final affirmative determinations in the antidumping duty (AD) and countervailing duty (CVD) investigations of melamine from India.

### Final Dumping Rates
