On April 1, 2025, the U.S. Department of Commerce (Commerce) announced its final affirmative determinations in the antidumping duty (AD) and countervailing duty (CVD) investigations of 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic Acid from the People's Republic of China (China) and India.
