Preliminary Affirmative Determinations in the Antidumping Duty Investigations of Paper File Folders from Cambodia and Sri Lanka

On May 22, 2025, the U.S. Department of Commerce (Commerce) announced its preliminary affirmative determination in the antidumping duty (AD) investigation of paper file folders from Sri Lanka and the preliminary negative determination in the AD investigation of paper file folders from Cambodia. Commerce is also conducting a concurrent countervailing duty (CVD) investigation of paper file folders from Cambodia.
