# **Commerce Initiates Antidumping and Countervailing Duty Investigations of Unwrought Palladium from the Russian Federation**

On August 20, 2025, the U.S. Department of Commerce (Commerce) announced the initiation of antidumping duty (AD) and countervailing duty (CVD) investigations of unwrought palladium from the Russian Federation (Russia).

- The U.S. International Trade Commission (ITC) is currently scheduled to issue its preliminary determination on September 15, 2025. For more information related to the ITC's timeline, please refer to the ITC's calendar.
- If the ITC issues an affirmative preliminary determination, Commerce is scheduled to announce its preliminary determination on October 23, 2025, for the CVD investigation, and on January 6, 2026, for the AD investigation. These deadlines may be extended in accordance with the statute.
