- For individual countries 'product standards, consult the "Customs, Regulations & Standards" section of a Country Commercial Guide.
- In the European Union (EU), your product may need a CE marking and certification.
- In China, many manufactured goods require China Compulsory Certification (CCC).
- Member countries of the World Trade Organization (WTO) are required under the Agreement on
 Technical Barriers to Trade (TBT Agreement) to report to the WTO all proposed technical regulations that
 could affect trade with other Member countries. You can sign up for Notify U.S., a free, web-based e-mail
 subscription service, for the opportunity to review and comment on proposed foreign technical regulations
 that can affect your access to international markets.
- The <u>International Organization for Standardization</u> (Organisation internationale de normalisation), widely known as ISO, is an international standard-setting body composed of representatives from various national standards organizations.
