The International Trade Administration is part of the inter-agency Infrastructure Transaction and Assistance Network (ITAN) led by the State Department's Office of Development Finance.

ITAN has three core functions:

- 1) Strengthening capacity-building programs to improve partner countries project evaluation processes, regulatory and procurement environments, and project preparation capacity;
- 2) Providing transaction advisory services to support sustainable infrastructure; and
- 3) Coordinating <u>U.S. assistance support for infrastructure</u> and catalyzing private-sector-led investment throughout the region.
