Commerce currently treats all countries not listed below as market economies for purposes of the U.S. antidumping and countervailing duty laws. An NME determination for a country remains in effect unless and until revoked by Commerce based on an in-depth analysis pursuant to the statutory criteria identified in section 771(18) of the Act.
