

November Monthly Steel Factsheet

December 23rd, 2020

The preliminary data released show that overall steel imports in November 2020 decreased 9.31 percent from October 2020 and a larger year-over-year decline of 12.68 percent. Though there were gains in some product categories, the monthly decline results from drops in larger categories. Of the products listed below, there were significant decreases in carbon and alloy oil country goods (-34.13%), slab (-25.13%), cold-rolled sheets (-14.54%), reinforcing bars (-12.45%), and galvanized hot dipped sheets and strip (-10.06%). Notable increases included carbon and alloy standard pipe (27.37%) and wire rod (21.03%). Year-over-year, significant declines occurred in carbon and alloy oil country goods (-70.52%), cold-rolled sheets (-23.11%), standard pipe (-19.23%) and slab (-17.30%) and significant gains occurred in wire rod (71.34%), reinforcing bars (19.80%) and stainless pipe and tubing (16.98%).
