

In July 2021, all major U.S. ports of entry reported YOY volume increases. Thirty-one (31) of the 40 major ports reported an increased volume in July 2021 compared the prior month (June 2021). Note: Monthly volume growth over the preceding month appears to be slowing.

Ports of entry in Texas and Florida are generally experiencing faster recovery toward 2019 volume levels (see graphic below). In July 2021, Ft. Lauderdale and Miami each reported more than 60% of their pre-COVID POE overseas visitor volume. However, most ports of entry are still experiencing volumes that are less than 20% of their pre-COVID level. Ft. Lauderdale, Miami, Houston, and Dallas are larger volume POEs compared to San Antonio and Portland.
