

There were 1,733,232 (+431.6% YOY) international visitors to the United States in June 2021 or 27.4% of the 6,343,310 visitors recorded for June 2019.



There were 786,200 overseas visitors to the United States in June 2021, an increase of +1,892.6% compared to June 2020. Including all modes of arrival, there were 861,899 total visitors from Mexico for June 2021 (+249.6%; INEGI). At the same time, there were 85,113 total visitors from Canada to the United States (+112.7%; Stats Canada).

All world regions reported an increase in visitor volume to the United States during June 2021. Central America recorded the largest increase (+12,679.3% YOY) with 144,917 visitors. The world region that reported the smallest percentage increase in June 2021 was Oceania. There were 3,442 arrivals from Oceania (+165.6% YOY).

All top 20 countries to the United States reported an increase in visitor volume in June 2021 compared to June 2020. Mexico reported the largest volume of visitors to the United States with 861,899 (+249.6% YOY). The largest percentage increase was recorded by Colombia (+33,744.2% YOY). Canada reported the smallest year-over-year percentage increase (+112.7%) of the top 20 countries to the United States.

All major U.S. metro-area gateways reported increases in visitor volume for June 2021 compared to June 2020. Miami reported the largest volume of visitor arrivals for June 2021 (296,361; +2,913.6% YOY). Miami recorded more than twice the visitor arrival volume of the next closest ports of New York (129,852) and Houston (117,394).
