

RENEWABLE ENERGY IN THE NORTH

OLD CROW, YUKON – OFF-GRID SOLAR



- Reduces diesel use by 190,000 litres annually
- Reduce CO2 emissions by 750 tonnes per year
- Vuntut Gwitchin First Nation and ATCO develop Electricity Purchase Agreement
- Community ownership in project

FORT CHIPEWYAN – OFF-GRID SOLAR & STORAGE



- Largest off-grid solar and storage in Canada
- Reduces diesel use by 800,000 litres annually
- Reduce CO2 emissions by 2,145 tonnes per year
- 2,200-kW farm owned by Three Nations Energy
- 600-kW farm owned / operated by ATCO
