Our Name and Logo

The sakku is a toggle harpoon head commonly used for hunting seals, whales and walruses.

Attached to a harpoon shaft and a cord, this ingenious invention rotates 90 degrees when triggered by the tension of the cord, preventing its escape.

It is representative of the endurance of Inuit culture and has, over many thousands of years, ensured its survival.



At a Glance

Sakku is the business arm of the Kivalliq Inuit Association, mandated with developing sustainable wealth for the Inuit of the Kivalliq region of Nunavut since 1989.

Sakku's Group of Companies consists of 20+ companies including three 100% owned subsidiaries, with a total of 650 employees in the Kivalliq

Current Initiative

Several new projects are always taking shape at Sakku. Currently, the two with the most far-reaching benefits for the region are

Sakku Innovative Building Solutions: the North's first modular housing factory, which will provide an Inuit-made solution to reverse Nunavut's severe housing shortage while also creating new employment and training opportunities;

Within a few years, SIBS will have the capacity to add hundreds of new homes to the region's housing infrastructure.

This could lead to a significant increase in the Kivalliq's social housing starts, as well as more housing for regional employers, such as mining companies
