Dear Ambassador antor:

With reference to the me etings between officials of the orean and U.S- Governments between March 21 and 24, 1995 concerning telecommunications issues of mutual interest, I am pleased to confirm the orean Government's understanding with respect to the following subjects.

- A. AT&T's 5ESS-2000: In accordance with the agreement reached between orea Telecom (T) and AT&T as a result of their discussions during the past several months, AT&T will be allowed to bid the 5ESS-2000 switching equipment for T's 1995 procurement.
- B. Type Approval of Telecommunications Equipment: With regard to CNT's products listed in Footnote one 1, pursuant to Article XIV. E of the 1992 orea-U.S. Understanding on Telecommunications and in response to the U.S. Government's letter and that of CNT of March 22, 1995 (attached), confirming that these products are not subject to U.S. Part 68 registration, the orean Government will not subject the same products to orea's type approval requirement. It is the orean Government's belief that its decision concerning CNT's products will serve to promote the harmonization of both countries' equipment approval regulations, and will also serve to further K the mutual commitment of the 1992 Understanding on Telecommunications regarding mutual recognition of equipment approval.

To this end, both Governments agree to hold experts meetings as promptly as possible in order to discuss various issues relating to mutual recognition of equipment approval, including criteria for determining which products do not require type approval. Pending the conclusion of these discussions, which shall be completed within six months, each Government will be prepared to review and decide in an expeditious manner that type approval is unnecessary for certain telecommunications equipment, once it has received adequate information establishing that the function of the equipment in question does not possess the potential to cause harm to a public network.

- C. Raychem's status as a supplier of Products listed in Footnote 2: T will exclude by the end of March 1995 Raychem's products listed in Footnote 2 from the list of products subject to T's qualification requirement. Upon such exclusion, Raychem will be allowed to bid directly for T's contracts pursuant to T's open, competitive procurement procedures.
- D. Use of leased circuits: The orean Government is considering taking additional measures some time this year K to further liberalize its leased line regulation, particularly as it relates to the interconnection between the public K switched network and leased circuits for domestic voice communications. E. Other e he Korean Government ha taken note of the U.S. Government' intere t in Korea' reg lation of r nked Radio Service RS) and Per onal Communication Service PCS), which area are not covered by the Under tanding on elecommunication between the two contrie. he Korea Government f rther note that Korea and the United State are actively participating in multilateral negotiation in Geneva concerning the liberalization of balic telecommunication ervice including wirele ervice), and confirms it willingne to discuss with the U.S. Government i elected to RS and PCS within the frame work of the ongoing WTO negotiation.
