Madagascar Navigation and Co rce Treaty

French convention applicable to Madagascar:

By a note dated Dece<sup>mb</sup>er 4, 1962, the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Malagasy Republic infor<sup>me</sup>d the A<sup>me</sup>rican A<sup>mb</sup>assador of the following (translation): "No official act specifies, in the agree<sup>me</sup>nts with the French Republic, the juridical position of the Malagasy Republic with regard to the rights and obligations contracted for Madagascar in the treaties, agree<sup>me</sup>nts, and conventions signed by France prior to Madagascar's accession to international sovereignty. In accordance with usage, the Malagasy Republic considers itself i<sup>mp</sup>licitly bound by such texts unless it explicitly denounces the<sup>m.</sup> The Ministry of Foreign Affairs infor<sup>ms</sup> the E<sup>mb</sup>assy of the United States of A<sup>me</sup>rica that, in order to avoid any a<sup>mb</sup>iguity, the Malagasy Republic trans<sup>mI</sup>ts, as soon as it is in a position to reach an affir<sup>ma</sup>tive decision on each of the texts in questions, a for<sup>ma</sup>I declaration in which it declares itself bound by the Treaty, the Agree<sup>me</sup>nt or the Convention under consideration."

Convention of navigation and correct between the United States and France, with separate article. 1 Signed at Washington June 24, 1822; extended to Madagascar in 1896.
