# June 3rd MEETING MINUTES

## Welcome and Committee Business

Designated Federal Officer (DFO) Megan Hyndman and ETTAC Chair Clare Schulzki welcomed committee members and began the meeting. Ground rules were discussed and the meeting minutes from the ETTAC April 15<sup>th</sup> meeting were approved.

## **Subcommittee Readouts**

ETTAC subcommittees provided readouts from their subcommittee meetings in May and June and discussed priority topics and key areas of focus for future recommendation letters.

#### **Open Discussion on Priority Issues**

Members discussed priority issues in their respective sectors and a variety of challenges and barriers ETTAC member companies are facing. Members expressed a desire to understand impacts of recent trade policies on small and medium size businesses and proposed this as a future area of deliberation.

## Working Lunch & Closed Session Subcommittee Meetings

ETTAC members broke out into their respective subcommittees and discussed their priorities and areas of engagement.

## **Briefing from the Small Business Administration**

The ETTAC received a briefing from the Small Business Administration (SBA) on trade finance mechanisms for U.S. small business exporters. The presenters provided an overview of SBA trade finance tools available to exporters and how SBA works with other agencies to ensure a coordinated approach to supporting U.S. small businesses.

## **ITA Updates**

Frances Selema, Global Environmental Technology Team Lead, briefed the ETTAC on upcoming ITA trade activities and events for the environmental technologies sector. DFO Hyndman and Alec Hilton briefed members on OEEI's supply chain research for key environmental technologies and received feedback from ETTAC members.

## Discussion with Deputy Assistant Secretary for Manufacturing Alex Krutz on ITA Priorities & Opportunities for ETTAC Feedback

Deputy Assistant Secretary Alex Krutz discussed Office of Manufacturing priorities to strengthen domestic manufacturing and increase the exports of U.S.-manufactured products. ETTAC members presented on the key themes they are deliberating on this charter and highlighted the topics they are currently considering for recommendation letters.

#### Next Steps, Public Comment

DFO Hyndman and ETTAC Chair Schulzki discussed next steps in the lead up to the next full ETTAC meeting in September. No issues were raised during the public comment period. The meeting was adjourned at 3:06 p.m.
