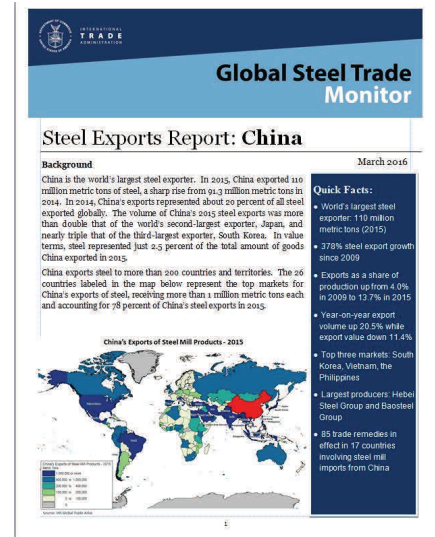

Enforcement and Compliance's Global Steel Trade Monitor provides **global import** and **export** trends for the **top countries** trading in steel products. The reports feature data regarding the largest importers and exporters of steel in the world, including China, Germany, Italy, Japan, Russia, South Korea, Turkey, the U.S. and many others. The current reports expand upon the early release information already provided by the Steel Import Monitoring and Analysis (SIMA) program that collects and publishes data on U.S. imports of steel mill products.

Complementing the SIMA data, these reports provide objective and current global steel industry information about the top countries that play an integral role in global steel trade. Information in these reports includes global export and import trends, production and consumption data and, where available, information regarding trade remedy actions taken on steel products. The reports will be updated quarterly.
